

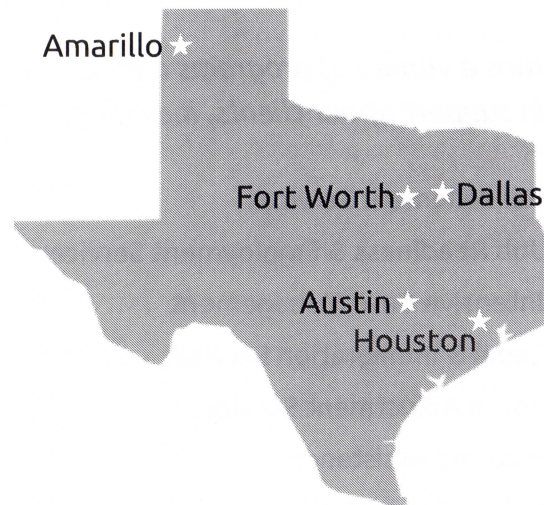
OUR MISSION

WHO WE SERVE

Refugees

People who flee their countries of origin due to a fear of persecution based on race, religion, nationality, political opinion, or membership in a social group.

Asylees

People who have left their countries of origin to seek asylum in another. They must meet the definition of a refugee but have secured their own travel.

Special Immigration Visas

Offered to Iraqi and Afghani citizens who face threats as a result of having worked with the U.S. military or U.S. contractors

Cuban-Haitian Entrants

Cubans and Haitians fleeing their country are granted asylum upon arrival on U.S. soil and are eligible for the same services as refugees.
